- 7) Why does Mildred want to be left alone on p.52?
- 8) As completely as possible, describe how society has changed according to Beattie's talk with Montag (p. 54-62). Draw parallels between what the future looks like in the story and what it is like today.
- 9) In your opinion, why does the mind "drink less" if there are more photos in books?
- 10) According to Beattie, how has the job of a fireman changed?
- 11) According to Beattie, what was wrong with Clarisse?
- 12) Explain why you think Montag is so angry after his chat with Beattie.
