

Grade 9 Speech

The following assignment will assess your thinking and communication skills, be graded out of 40, and marked using the following rubric. Please ensure that you hand your rubric to me on the date of your speech.

Not everybody likes to give speeches, but oral communication is extremely important no matter what you plan on doing after high school; whether it's arguing a speeding ticket, or trying to explain to your parents why you didn't come home until 6am. Public speaking is a way of life and this next assignment is designed to assess your public speaking skills. I know that they are pretty good as you have no problem talking to your classmates during class time, so think of this as that, but on a larger scale.

I am not going to bore you and ask you to write a speech that introduces your favourite person, or to talk to the class about things such as your favourite ice cream flavour. Your task is as follows:

TASK
