Remember that you have to cover all aspects of Canadian history, so don't just do music and the hippy movement or disco when covering the 60's and 70's.

This assignment will assess your thinking and communication skills, be graded out of 80 and marked with the attached marking scheme that you must submit with your final copy on the due date. There will be some time in class to work on this but it is also homework (you do homework in applied courses because the applied stream prepares you for College and/or Trade School and there is home work at both of those places).
